Program Description:

This is a new study program conducted in English. The program was created in response to the growing demand of the labor market for specialists in the field of adult education.

The studies aim to prepare graduates for work as educators, trainers, and educational program developers, with particular emphasis on the needs of the job market. The program focuses on developing skills necessary for working in the field of non-formal and informal education for adults.

Students will have ample opportunities to shape their career paths, gaining competencies in entrepreneurship, career planning, communication, and many other areas, such as:

- design of developmental activities for adults;
- multicultural perspective of adult education;
- educational leadership;
- modern technologies in education;
- education for business;
- personal development;
- LifeCraft: life and career path planning.

Teaching activities mainly take place at the Faculty building (16/20 Mokotowska Street) from Monday to Friday according to the academic calendar.
